**Name:** Type Confusion Bug Exploited in Google Chrome

**Threat Classification:** Vulnerability

**Affected Software / Services:**

- Google Chrome Web Browser

**Summary:**

Google has released security updates to address a type confusion bug, tracked as CVE-2023-3079, in its Chrome web browser. The vulnerability in the V8 JavaScript engine is actively being exploited in the wild. It allows a remote attacker to potentially exploit heap corruption via a crafted HTML page.

<b>Severity</b>	<b>Critical</b>
<b>Attack Vector</b>	Network, Crafted HTML page

**Recommendations:**

- Users should update their Google Chrome browser to version 114.0.5735.110 for Windows and 114.0.5735.106 for macOS and Linux to mitigate potential threats.
- Users of Chromium-based browsers such as Microsoft Edge, Brave, Opera, and Vivaldi should apply the available security fixes as soon as they are released.
