**Name:** Multiple Google Products Vulnerabilities

**Threat Classification:** Vulnerabilities

**Affected Software / Area:**

- Google Chrome Version 129.0.6668.58
- Google Nest Wifi Pro Version 3.73.424613

**Summary:**

Two critical vulnerabilities have been identified in Google products. CVE-2024-8904 impacts Google Chrome, allowing remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a type confusion error in V8. CVE-2024-22013 affects Google Nest Wifi Pro, where a flaw in the U-Boot component could enable local authenticated attackers to gain elevated privileges.

**Recommendations:**

- Upgrade to the latest version of Google Chrome immediately to mitigate these vulnerabilities. The latest version is available from the Google Chrome Releases website.
